COMPETITIVE EDGE'S BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT PLAN

Our goal is to provide a safe environment for children to develop a healthy spirit, mind and body. We believe that children should make their own choices and take responsibility for their actions. Our policy is that behavior management is a function of engaging children in meaningful and stimulating activities which focus on positive role models, in addition to promoting respect for one's self and others in a climate of acceptance and fairness.

Acceptable Behaviors

- Based on the Golden Rule: "Treat others as you would want them to treat you."
- Children will respect the rights and feelings of others and will avoid disruptive behavior that would interfere with activities.
- Aggressive behaviors such as excessive force, verbal put-downs, and bullying will not be tolerated. Children will follow all directions given by the teacher and aids regarding safety procedures and will stay with the group for all scheduled activities.
- Children will respect the private property of others and will understand that stealing or vandalizing the property of others will not be tolerated.

Behavior Management Procedures

Step 1: When a problem arises which threatens the health or safety of him/herself, other children or staff, the staff will take immediate action to stop the behavior and inform the child of the disciplinary action that will be taken. If the severity of the inappropriate behavior warrants, or the child cannot be controlled in the area, it may be necessary to temporarily remove the child from the situation. The Parent/Guardian will be notified, and we will work together with the child to correct the inappropriate behavior.

Step 2: A call the parent/guardian to discuss the continuing inappropriate behavior. Should the behavior continue, the child will be suspended from the program. A conference between site staff, the program director, and the parent/quardian may be scheduled at this time.

Step 3: The Program Director will inform the parent/guardian (via phone call) of a three-day suspension for the continuing inappropriate behavior. No care will be provided by Competitive Edge. The parent/quardian remains responsible for paying all fees for that month. A written letter will be sent home outlining the suspension.

Step 4: After a third call from the Program Director has been made, and there have been several unsuccessful attempts to correct the child's behavior, the Program Director will notify the parent/guardian that the child is withdrawn from the Completive Edge After school program. Written notification will follow.

***When a child's inappropriate behavior is extremely persistent in that it takes too much attention away from the needs and safety of the other children or the behavior is too violent, the

possibility of suspending or dismissing the child from the program may immediately. This decision is an important and difficult one to make. It was considered and discussed before action is taken.

COMPETITIVE EDGE COVID CLEANING PROCEDURES.

- Before class wipe all door handles, tables, and banisters with a liquid disinfectant
- When students come into the gym their temp must be taken. (anyone 100.00 F and above must be sent home)
- Students must sanitize their hands before coming into the facility
- Masks must be worn at all times.
- During class, please try to keep your distance from others and refrain from touching one another
- Masks are recommended but not required during class time, however during down time masks are required and must be on
- After class mats are mopped with liquid disinfectant
- All equipment will be sprayed /wiped down with a liquid disinfectant
- After students leave wipe all door handles, tables, and banisters with a liquid disinfectant

Your workout routine will now look like this:

- Enter the facility, wearing a mask
- Get temperature checked and screened at the door
- Parents should wait for their children outside. Drop offs are strongly encouraged
- Parents / students needed to keep mask on throughout their visit
- You can remove your mask if you feel you cannot safely perform your studies. You must be socially distant from other students before removing your mask.
- Place your mask back on if you have taken it off before joining your classmates
- Clean piece of equipment after use, using provided spray bottle

Other Protocols While at: Competitive Edge

- Masks are not required to be worn when outside the facility and social distancing is strongly encouraged.
- Members participating in outdoor group exercise classes, and who remain socially distant, are not required to wear a mask.
- During the screening process, you will have your temperature taken. If over 100.4 degrees, you will not be allowed to enter the facility
- Screening questions include: "Have you traveled to any of the states listed by Governor Wolfe as a hot spot?" If the answer is yes, we ask that you self-quarantine for 14 days.

Providing safe places for students to learn.

Competitive Edge has created a safe place for students in grade K -8th grade. This center will be open from 7 am-6 pm Monday through Friday. The purpose of this centers is to provide a safe setting in which students can learn among their peers during the times their schools are in virtual learning. While students are participating in our school program they are welcome to attend our Saturday classes.

The centers will be run by our trusted team (certified teach & aids), providing organized and supervised time dedicated to school work, along with time for play and physical activity. Social distancing does not have to mean social isolation. Feeling connected can improve a child's resiliency. Going to the Competitive Edge's **Virtual learning program** will provide a routine to increase their feeling of safety and security. And finally, having physical activity and fun will help keep their minds fresh and balanced.

Our Center program structure will be as follows:

- Days can be from 7 am 6 pm serving grades K 8
- Enrichment Activities (Martial Arts classes)
- Time dedicated for remote learning We will accommodate specific virtual schedules
- Students will enjoy throughout the day to promote physical activity and a chance to recharge and focus
- Students will have the opportunity to participate in our martial art program
